

How much does it cost to ship a container?

In general, for full container load shipment, port charges are fixed and won't vary significantly. For example, at Ningbo Port, port charges for a 20-foot GP container are about \$330, and for a 40-foot HQ container, port charges are about \$480. Here the exchange rate is 7 and the export customs declaration fee is \$50.

What are common port charges?

Common port charges include fees for cargo handling, storage, berthing, and documentation. Key charges are Port Handling Charges (PHC), Terminal Handling Charges (THC), demurrage, detention, dock dues, and wharfage. Charges vary based on port infrastructure, cargo type, shipment volume, and port management (public vs private).
