Where are EnerSys batteries made?

As part of this strategic initiative, EnerSys will permanently close its flooded lead-acid battery manufacturing facility located in Monterrey, Mexico. The production activities from this facility will be transitioned to the company's existing plant in Richmond, Kentucky.

Who makes LTH batteries in Mexico?

Will EnerSys restructure its flooded lead battery plant?

Meanwhile, EnerSys will invest \$4.5 million to expand flooded lead battery production capacity in its Bielsko-Biala, Poland facility. The restructuring is expected to deliver an estimated pre-tax benefit of \$19 million annually, beginning fiscal year 2027, while ensuring continued product availability and customer support, the company said.
